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necessary to go through it and transcribe each word, number, and symbol. If you were a customer, you'd want a transcriber to spend the extra time to check each word or number that was recorded, and you'd certainly expect to receive a transcript that accurately captures the words you said. You want a transcript that reflects the real message and not just a small portion of the message that was spoken. When transcribing a message, transcribers also need to keep in mind a few points: Scrutinize the message and notice if there are any spelling errors. If it's a short message, transcribe just the first few minutes of the recording. If the message is long, break it up into several smaller pieces. Tip #2: Avoid Using Too Many Spelling Checks When you work with a transcription service, you can usually type in the words and numbers yourself.
